

# LCA's Reentry Plan



We will open on **Monday, August 17, 2020** with in-person, traditional instruction and added safety measures. There will be a virtual learning option for at-risk, immune compromised, or quarantined students. Going forward into the school year, the model below will be followed based on the spread of Covid-19 in our community.



## Cleaning

- We will be using industry approved & effective cleaning products on high-touch areas around the schools
- Sanitizing stations will be placed in key locations throughout both campuses
- There will be designated times for student hand washing
- Cleaning will take place throughout the day and deep cleaning will occur after each school day

## Instruction

- All teachers will receive virtual learning and Covid protocol training
- Masks will be required if social distancing (3-6 feet) is not able to be practiced
- Instruction taking place outdoors will be encouraged
- Supply sharing between students and teachers will be minimized
- Online learning will be integrated

## Parental Partnership

This year will be a team effort between faculty, students, and parents. To prevent any spread of Covid, we are encouraging parents to do the following:

- Utilize the Covid symptoms checklist daily
- Check the temperature of their student each morning
- Keep sick children at home
- Provide a mask for elementary students - secondary masks are provided
- Provide a refillable water bottle

# School-Wide Protocol

## Communication

On August 17th, a Covid dashboard will be viewable on the website and any urgent information will be emailed.

## Field Trips

Field trips that are able to provide proper social distancing will be allowed.

## Visitors

No non-essential visitors will be admitted into either building. Essential visitors will be screened upon entry.

## Back-to-School Events

Orientation will be a recorded event and open houses will be scheduled on August 13th & 14th to meet teachers.

## Quarantining

Individuals or households with a positive Covid result will be quarantined for 10-14 calendar days before returning to school (according to direction of Kosciusko County Health Department).

## Covid Symptoms

Students must stay home if they have a fever over 100° (LCA policy) and be fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicine, be symptom-free for 10 days before returning to school, or have a negative Covid test result

## How will it look?

### PK-K

Mask required when unable to social distance (3-6 feet)
